It provides a snapshot of birds recorded in the valley and I hope you will find it of interest. Of course there are many gaps in our knowledge about the birds in the valley and so there is a greater need for as many members as possible to contribute their observations. For instance there is scope for more records about:-

- the existence or otherwise of heronries in the valley besides the one which is counted each year at Great Witchingham
- the location of rookeries and the number of active nests in them.
- the first and last dates of migrant species sightings
- the number of breeding Mute Swan in the valley, etc

I could continue but must emphasise that whatever you feel is of significance is worthy of recording.


